Brian has worked many years helping those in need after major disasters have taken place in the gulf coast area. He was in Louisiana when Hurricane Katrina hit, and then Hurricane Rita. It was during that time that he was introduced to the work of CCDRE, and got involved, helping to request, unload and distribute the supplies we provide. He also helped those in need after Hurricane Ike, the BP Oil Spill, the flooding in 2016 along the Louisiana-Texas border, and in 2017 with Hurricane Harvey. In 2019 he helped after the flooding from Hurricane Barry and Tropical Storm Imelda, before he began working for CCDRE in September.

Brian and his family currently live in Louisiana, and he travels to speak to congregations and work with disasters in LA, TX, OK, & NM.
